By my signature at the bottom of this page, I acknowledge the following:

- I may participate in ACHA Women's Division 2 games ONLY if I am a student enrolled by my team's university.
- I must enroll in and complete ("pass") a minimum of **6 credit hours per semester**. If I am in my last term of study before graduation, I must enroll in a minimum of 3 credit hours. An equivalent number will be used for campuses following a quarter system.
- All ACHA student-athletes must maintain a cumulative GPA of at least 2.0 (on a 4.0 scale) by the beginning of a student-athlete's second year of eligibility (after two semesters of ACHA play). No student-athlete will be able to add alter or change her Cumulative GPA or credits between semesters in a "J" term or "Winter" term (a short term in between two regular semesters or quarters).
- If I have participated in the sport of ice hockey for an NCAA or CIS ("varsity") team, or with an ACHA Women's Division 1 team, there are certain eligibility requirements (listed in Items 5 and 6 below), which pertain to me. I also must disclose my status with any NCAA/CIS/ACHAW1 team in the "Declaration of Previous Teams" below.
- I am allowed 6 years of total ACHA Women's Division 2 eligibility. If I have been on an NCAA/CIS/ACHAW1 hockey team at any time, I am only allowed 4 years of ACHA Women's Division 2 eligibility, minus the time spent at the NCAA/CIS/ACHAW1 level. Playing just 1 NCAA/CIS game during a season will utilize a year of my ACHA eligibility. Playing in 20% of a team's ACHA Women's Division 1 games will utilize a year of my ACHA eligibility.
- I have not participated with an NCAA/CIS ice hockey team for ANY university's team during the same season I plan to play in the ACHA Women's Division. **Note: This includes transfer students.**
- I am not a "satellite" student (from another branch of my university) or a student from another school with "reciprocal" sports programs. I understand that this rule applies even if my university would normally allow this type of participation.
- I have never played the sport of ice hockey professionally.
- I am not to receive any financial disbursements, for any reason, directly from the college hockey program, booster club or hockey program sponsor.
- I may only receive financial aid which has been properly channeled through my college/university's financial aid office. Financial aid shall be awarded on a need basis only as determined by the United States Department of Education Standards for Financial Assistance Program formula as applied to each institution.
